Launch of the Canadian Rheumatology Association Foundation

Canadian Rheumatology Association, February 9, 2023 – The Canadian Rheumatology Association (CRA) is pleased to announce the launch of the Canadian Rheumatology Association Foundation (CRAF). The foundation was born out of the vision of the CRA, a national voice for practicing rheumatologists and researchers with an interest in rheumatic diseases.

While the CRA focuses on promoting and advancing the field of rheumatology by organizing networking, training and education opportunities for clinicians, students, allied health professionals and researchers, the CRAF will focus on funding research and training of future Rheumatologists.

Dr. Ahmad Zbib, Executive Director of the CRAF, shares, “While we have great therapies for several rheumatic diseases, we still do not have cures, and in some cases, we don’t even have great treatment options for certain conditions. Research presents opportunities to change that. We hope to build a sizeable endowment, which will help us to continue, and ideally grow, our funding of research.”

We are pleased to announce that Dr. Vandana Ahluwalia, past president of the Canadian Rheumatology Association, is the founding Chair of the CRAF Board. Dr. Ahluwalia is a respected physician and is a member of the Rheumatology Division of the William Osler Health Centre in Brampton, Ontario. Her leadership and passion for this project will provide the guidance needed to achieve our mission to serve Rheumatologists so they can deliver the best care possible to their patients.
